This season's concerts have been curated by Scottish Opera Music Director, **Francesco Corti**, who conducts two of the concerts in the series. We also welcome exciting young Spanish conductor **Sergio Alapont**, making his UK debut.

Our September concert sees Baritone **Thomas Oliemans** and Mezzo-soprano **Leah Marian-Jones** singing a selection of beautiful arias from Mozart's much-loved opera *The Marriage of Figaro*. The third concert in the series also offers a wonderful opportunity to hear Principal Oboist **Joseph Houghton** in Richard Strauss's fantastic Oboe Concerto in D Major.
