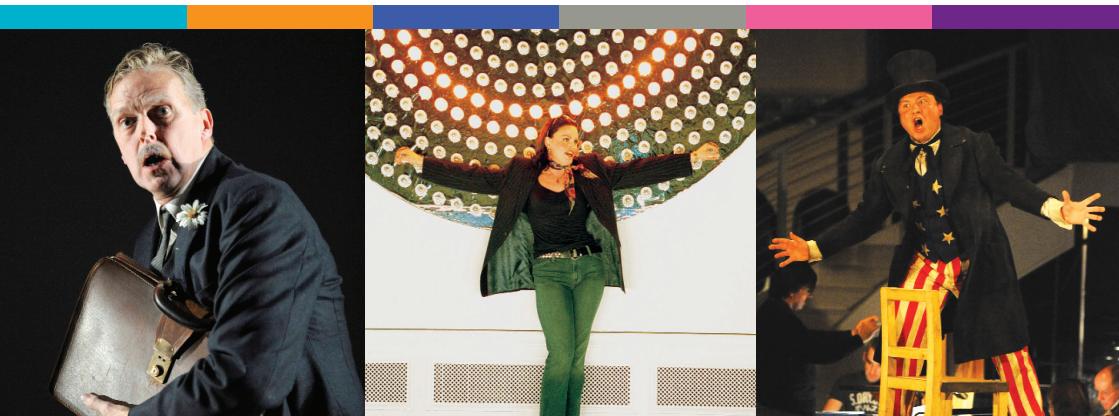


# Study Days 2010
