# Wigs & Make Up Workroom & Offices at Edington Street Production Studios

- Assisting Wigs Supervisor to build all aspects of Wig and Make-Up requirements for upcoming productions.
- Attending fittings, taking notes
- Assisting Wigs Supervisor in preparing Wigs, Hair and Make-Up Bibles
- Assisting Wigs Supervisor in sourcing and testing new products
- Acting as Wigs Supervisor for small projects under the guidance of senior staff

## Running Wigs at Production Studios, Theatre Royal and on tour

- Wig Dressing work, wig care and storage, packing for get-ins and get-outs on tour
- Wig maintenance and make-up stock control
- Assisting Wigs Supervisor on large scale productions
- Attending tour production meetings as required
- Touring with the production

# Wigs Store work at Production Studios

- Organizing and maintaining wig stock
- Assessing and carrying out repairs as required
- Updating wig stock data base

## **General duties**

- Assisting in any other areas of Wigs, Hair and Make-Up work as required
- Office tasks: filing, photocopying, ordering products by telephone and email
- Entering wig records on computer database
- Researching period hair and make-up styling
- Working closely with the Costume department and Costume Designers to realize the design brief

- Working as part of a team with all technical and production departments
- Maintaining high standards of safety in the workplace
- Assisting with keeping up to date COSHH records
- Helping to promote Scottish Opera's Emerging Artists program to funders and press

#### **Training**

- Receiving instruction from senior staff in all the above areas
- Studying the process of setting, dressing and styling period and contemporary hairstyles.
- Learning how to take full head wraps and measurements for wig foundations
- Learning to knot period facial hair
- Learning to repair lace fronted wigs
- · Learning wefting techniques
- Development of period make-up techniques and SFX techniques, including bald caps
- Studying the history of hair and make-up
- Learning simple planning skills, budget management and acquisition techniques
- Learning preparation of a wig's bible, wigs plot and dressing notes
